#### **Definition of Session**

This part of the training program deals with how to thoroughly examine the parts of the animals body in a proper scientific manner, and to identify the apparent problems expected to be seen in each part of the body and how to examine and treat them. It will also address how to link the symptoms that appear on the animal to different body diseases, the method of examination and diagnosis, and how to control the animal and deal with its different behaviors during the examination process



#### Animal Behavioral part

Examining pets in clinics has become a challenging and exhausting process for both veterinarians and owners. Therefore, this workshop focuses on essential skills needed for effectively handling your pet, understanding its behavior, and how to deal with it properly to foster positive associations. The workshop will utilize behavioral training and focus on non-forceful methods, including using a 'Clicker' training tool. Demonstrative clips will be shown to illustrate various behaviors and how to handle them effectively. We'll also learn methods to prepare the pet before visiting the veterinarian, how to get it ready for clinical settings, and what to do after the visit to reduce anxiety and aggression while improving trust for owners, staff, and veterinarians.

Teeth cleaning is one of the most important procedures that must be adhered to in order to prevent oral and gum diseases. There is no doubt that the cooperation of the pet with its owner and veterinarian greatly facilitates the process during repeated clinic visits. Together, we will learn the most important methods used during oral examinations and teeth cleaning using "Clicker Training." We will also familiarize ourselves with veterinary tools and create positive associations with dental equipment, understanding body language, and handling various reactions from your pet. Starting from training and familiarization with the veterinarian's tools, we will learn how to reduce sensitivity to handling the mouth and accepting examination and cleaning tools, ensuring the teeth cleaning process is smooth, effective, and stress-free.
